How it works:

AMSA wants to recognize and reward all the members who demonstrate active participation!

There are several ways to rack up your points: attendance at general meetings and action committee events, participation in action committees, community service, etc. Below is a full list of valid items and how many points each will earn you.

At the end of the fall semester, we will recognize members in good standing at our winter social (Wed, Dec. 4, 7-10 pm – in case you were wondering when it is). Please attend and be proud of your AMSA involvement!

At the end of the spring semester, we will tally your points from fall and spring. Actual prizes will be awarded at the end of the year. Tentatively, there is a Kaplan prep course scholarship for the member who racks up the most points throughout the year. So keep up the active participation if you want great prizes in the spring!

Approximate number of events:

1. General Meetings/Action Committee Events (approx. 13)
2 pts each
2. Community Service events (approx. 4)
3 pts each + bonus points for staying at all-day events (e.g. Relay for Life)
3. Kaplan events (approx. 2)
3 pts each
4. Conferences (approx. 3)
5 pts
5. Joining/active participation on the Board or in Action Committees (Max: 2 ACs/person)*
10 pts/officer position, 5 pts/committee

Total Pts ** = 69

*Officers/AC Chairs do not get more than 10 points for the "Board/AC" category, even if they participate in one or more ACs

**Total points will vary depending on the actual number of each type of event per semester
