1. Lower Sproul Update – DeeJay

- Proposal #1 (our proposal) was accepted by the architects
- The ground floor has approx. 1100 sq. feet that is intended for the RRCs. It is up to ASUC to make that official.
- CalTV is also on that same floor but they're trying possibly having them moved to NAIA Lounge, etc.
- We have the same issue with Storage Space
- Practice and performance space is also in the basement
- How that 1100 sq. feet will look is a conversation that we will be having the future. But chances are we probably won't have walls but may be able to do cubicles.
- 1100 square feet may have 3 offices that we would have to figure out how to allocate on our own
- Question: Should we organize?
 - o Students have been pushing really hard but what has been difficult is the fact that they're trying to pit student groups against each other.
- Question: Can we make a meeting with the RRCs and administrations?
