1. Update on SURGE Space – DeeJay

- There are some things that need to be figured out and decisions that need to be made.
- There's a problem with the RRC space. Originally they thought that they would have part of the first floor of Hearst Gym.
- The idea was to move RRC space to the basement since it would be 24 hours.
- The spaces they were originally decided on (Option 2)
- The issue with this new plan is that there are Native American remains down the hall down where the pool entrance is. They're supposed to be moved but probably won't be moved during that time.
- NARRC is not on board to occupy that particular space. With that in mind, what should we do considering there was already a decision made. NARRC may be able to keep their office in Chavez
- Other options would be to go back to the first floor which would be less space and probably not ideal. Also, security might be an issue with this particular space. (Option 1)
- Another option will be a room from PE being given to Auxiliary which will free up more student space but not by that much. (Option 3)
- In the plan with the Auxiliary with students it's only the three advisors.
- The Annex is going to the MCC during lower Sproul redevelopment, that's what they were trying to get for RRCs at first.
- Next meeting with them is on November 5
