Since the program's founding in 1965, Cal in the Capital has continued to grow and capture the attention of decision makers from UC to Capitol Hill and beyond. Today, CITC receives over 200 applications for the 75 coveted annual internships. As the numbers suggest, the desire of today's Cal student to have an impact is alive and well. **It is our goal that soon no student is prohibited from participating due to cost.**

Driven by the success of the program, the motivation of the student directors, and the demand of applicants, Cal in the Capital is working to expand partnerships, create new internship opportunities, and make the program affordable for all eligible students. **The cost to students for the 10-week program is just under \$5,000, and just out of reach for nearly 40 percent of Cal students.**
