# What is Managed Care?

Managed care is an organized health care delivery system designed to improve both the quality and the accessibility of health care, including pharmaceutical care, while containing costs. Managed care pharmacy will continue to grow and have an integral role in patient care, and no matter which practice setting pharmacists choose to work in, managed care pharmacy will affect them in some way.

The role of the managed care pharmacist is to provide accessible and appropriate pharmaceutical care. In order to achieve this, pharmacists can participate in Pharmacy & Therapeutics Committees that evaluate medications based on cost and effectiveness and deciding which medication should be placed on the formulary for treatment. This decision will affect millions of patients at once and pharmacists are needed as a valuable resource.

The Academy of Managed Care Pharmacy (AMCP) is the national professional society dedicated to the concept and practice of pharmaceutical care in managed health care environments. AMCP's mission is to promote the development and application of pharmaceutical care in order to ensure appropriate health care outcomes for all individuals.
