

What can I recycle in the residence halls?

Aluminum and Tin: aluminum cans, food/soup cans and lids (no aluminum foil!)

Glass: clear, brown, and green

Plastic Bottles: #1 (PETE) and #2 (HDPE), rinsed

Mixed Paper: **YES**: white paper, colored paper, magazines, newspaper, brown paper bags, paperback books, junk mail, phone books, etc...
NO: pizza boxes, milk cartons, paper plates, napkins, cups, anything contaminated with food, carbon paper

Cardboard: flattened and without packaging

Batteries: all kinds

Inkjet and Toner Cartridges

Computer Monitors and TVs

Where can I recycle in the residence halls?

Units 1, 2, & 3:

Mixed paper: recycling chutes by the elevator

Food & beverage containers: rinse & place underneath bathroom sinks

Cardboard: empty, flatten, & place next to paper chute or take to mixed paper dumpsters at loading dock

Batteries: SM booth

College Durant: 1st floor recycling/trash room

Beverly Cleary: recycling room on each floor

Manville: ground floor trash room

Foothill: in buildings 2 & 7

Stern: outside by trash bins

Bowles: outside by loading dock

Clark Kerr: outside buildings 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, & 19

Monitors, TVs, ink cartridges: inquire at unit office or ask your RREC

What can I do with stuff at the end of the semester?

Re-USE: Take advantage of the re-used stuff emporium on campus! Donate reusable stuff to them and pick up stuff you need. Check <http://recycle.berkeley.edu/reuse.html> for hours, location, and other info.

Used reader and notebook collection drive: Designated recycling bins will be placed to collect your old readers and notebooks. Re-USE will then catalogue them and give them away for free the following semester.

Goodwill drive: Donate unwanted stuff to charity! A drop-off location in each unit will be designated at the end of the school year.
