

AMENDMENTS TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION

- (1) Freedom of religion, speech, press, petition, and assembly
- (2) The right to keep and bear arms
- (3) No quartering of soldiers in private houses during peace time
- (4) Protection against unreasonable searches and seizures, including specific warrants
- (5) Due process, self-incrimination, and double jeopardy
- (6) Rights of the accused and right to a speedy public trial
- (7) Right to trial by jury in civil cases
- (8) No excessive bail, fines, or cruel and unusual punishment
- (9) Rights of a person cannot come into conflict with or deny another person's rights
- (10) Unenumerated rights are reserved to the states or to the people
- (11) Immunity of states to foreign suits
- (12) Revision of presidential election procedures
- (13) Abolition of slavery
- (14) Citizenship with rights of due process and equal protection
- (15) Racial suffrage
- (16) Federal income tax
- (17) Direct election to the United States Senate
- (18) Prohibition of alcohol (repealed by 21st amendment)
- (19) Female suffrage
- (20) Term commencement for Congress and the President; "lame duck amendment"
- (21) Repeal of Eighteenth Amendment, but state and local prohibition permitted
- (22) Limits the President to two terms
- (23) Representation of Washington, D.C. in Electoral College
- (24) Prohibition of poll taxes
- (25) Presidential disabilities
- (26) Voting age nationally established as age 18
- (27) Variance of congressional compensation
