Offer an interpretation of how Rousseau's social contract—roughly, everyone's agreeing to do only what the general will allows—makes it possible that "each... may still obey himself alone, and remain as free as before." The objection can be philosophical, or interpretive (i.e., that the interpretation is in tension with other parts of Rousseau's text), or both.
