Topic:

Hobbes offers two explanations of how we might relinquish our "rights of nature" and become obligated to obey a single decision-maker (i.e., a "sovereign") in such a way as to successfully escape the "state of war." One explanation he calls "institution"; the other explanation he calls "acquisition."

Choose <u>one</u> of these explanations (i.e., either institution or acquisition, but not both). Give an interpretation of how the explanation works. Raise what, in your opinion, is a serious objection to the explanation (so interpreted). <u>If</u> you think that the objection can be overcome, then explain how. <u>If instead</u> you think that the objection is compelling, then explain what you think the implications are for the possibility of justifying political authority.
