Academic Preparation FAQs

Do I need a Bachelor's Degree?

Yes, you must either already have a bachelor's degree or complete your bachelor's degree by the end of the summer of the year in which you wish to enroll.

Do I have to have a minimum GPA to apply?

Yes, you must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA in order to apply.

Does it matter which undergraduate schools I attend?

No, as long as the schools you've attended are accredited.

Do I have to choose a specific major?

No, however, we recommend a science major because it is easier to fulfill your prerequisite coursework.

Do I have to complete the course requirements before I apply?

No, however, like the bachelor's degree, your coursework must be completed by the end of the summer of the year in which you wish to enroll.

Do you recommend any other courses?

We recommend that you take some upper-division courses in biochemistry, physiology, or cellular and molecular biology.

Can I apply to your program if I am an international student?

No, you must be a U.S. citizen or U.S. permanent resident to apply. However, we do accept international coursework. Learn more at: https://pharmacy.ucsd.edu/admissions/international-transcripts

Do you require the PCAT?

No, we do not require any standardized tests.

What is the deadline for applications?

The deadline for applications is November 1st. When November 1st falls on a weekend, the deadline is the following Monday.

How many applicants do you accept each year?

Each year we accept 65-70 students.


